



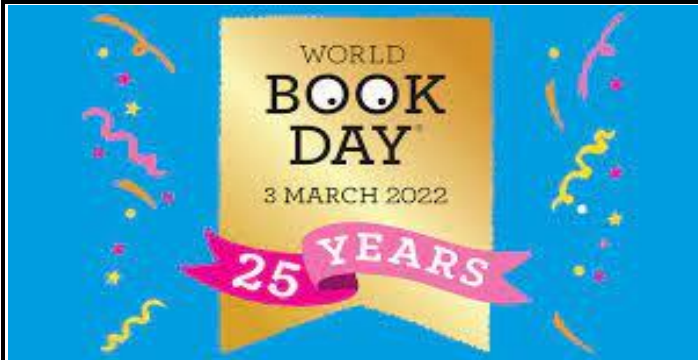

URGENT NOTICE
Food Choking Hazards For Toddlers and Preschoolers
Parents / Carers please note the following:

Popcorn and marshmallows are no longer allowed in Preschool. This is an EYFS ruling, due to these foods being a choking hazard.

Please cut sausages and small round fruits like grapes, cherries, berries, strawberries and cherry tomatoes, into small pieces. That means cut lengthways and then again cut them in half again.

Summer Term Funding Forms
Summer Term Funding Forms for 3-4 year olds and eligible 2 year olds will be placed in your child's tray in the first week back after the Spring half term. Please ensure you complete the forms in full and return to Pre-school by Friday 1st March 2024. Please can we also remind parents who are claiming the 30 hour funding to reconfirm your information within the 90 day timeframe – you should receive an email from HMRC when you are required to do this.



Illness
Children should be kept at home for 48 hours after the last bout of illness. If you are unsure whether to send your child to Pre-school, please phone and check with the Pre-school first. We also ask that you phone and let us know if your child is not attending Pre-school for any reason.
